THE DECREE. In view of the considerations set forth by the Intendente general of Finance in his report of the 2d inst. I hereby decree the following:

Articles 1.—All the estates, properties and assets confiscated (condemned) to the Treasury in consequence of the insurrection shall be immediately sold at public auction.

Article 2.—The entire proceeds of the sale of these estates, properties and assets shall be applied exclusively to the payment of a part of the debt of the Treasury by withdrawing from circulation bank notes issued on account of the 1855 paper.

Article 3.—With respect to estates which are under lease, that shall be effected without prejudice to previous contracts.
